



Criteria for Solution Assessment

General Rules

Below you see the **maximum score** for each item of each of the three problems. Errors in explanations (be it a miscalculation or a logical gap) may pull this score down.

Problem 1 (30 points)

- A correct and properly justified answer to items 1.A), 1.B): 8 points each;
- A correct and properly justified answer to question 2: 14 points;

Problem 2 (30 points)

- A correct and properly justified answer to question 1: 10 points;
- A correct and properly justified answer to question 2: 20 points.

Problem 3 (40 points)

- A correct and properly justified construction in items 1.A)–1.C): 5 points each;
- A correct and properly justified answer to question 2: 10 points;
- A correct and properly justified answer to question 3: 15 points.
