



Criteria for Solution Assessment

General Rules

Below you see the **maximum score** for each item of each of the three problems. Errors in explanations (be it a miscalculation or a logical gap) may pull this score down.

Problem 1 (20 points)

- A correct answer: 10 points (5 points for each of the two correct features);
- A justification of the answer by a funny story: 10 points.

Problem 2 (40 points)

- A correct and properly justified answer to question 1a: 5 points;
- A correct and properly justified answer to question 1b: 15 points;
- A correct and properly justified answer to question 2: 20 points.

Problem 3 (40 points)

- A correct and properly justified answer to question a: 5 points;
- A correct and properly justified answer to question b: 10 points;
- A correct and properly justified answer to question c: 15 points;
- A correct and properly justified answer to question d: 10 points.
